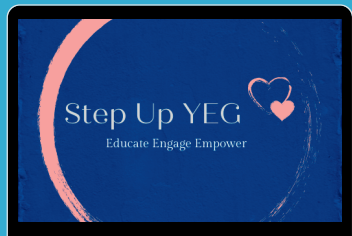

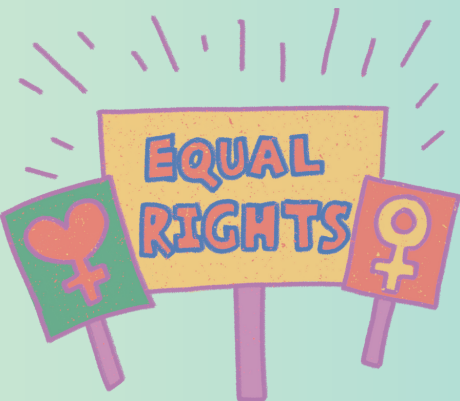
Steps to Take to be Anti-racist

1. Educate yourself

The first step is to **gain knowledge** about racism and the **effects** it has on different communities.



To be anti-racist, you need to **educate yourself** on the **history** of the **oppressed** and expand your knowledge regarding **current events** by learning about systemic racism, racial representation, etc...



2. Hold yourself and those around you accountable

As someone who has educated themselves on racism, it is now your job to **hold yourself accountable** when you find yourself believing certain **stereotypes**, or showing **prejudice** towards someone.

In addition, go out of your way to **educate your social circle**, or to encourage them to seek out their own education.



3. Support anti-racist policies

Whether it be at your workplace or a local election, you need to actively check if your vote is supporting **policies** that are working towards **dismantling the racism** prevalent in our systems today.
