Meaning: A tall, beautiful forest in the Mohawk

language.

Fun Fact: Michel Karhiio was the Chief of the

Michel band that was enfranchised in 1958.

This guidebook is funded by gaining public votes as a part of Councillor Keren Tang's Community-Based Budgeting Project


Guide to Ward Karhiio

Established in December of 2018, this family-run business aims to bring the culture of Latin America to Edmonton. They prioritize multicultural food and their food represents various parts of latin America.




